Sigalot's paper planes are made entirely out of metal, crafted meticulously to resemble the folds and creases of a traditional paper plane. The artist uses this material to create a sense of contrast between the fragility of paper and the durability of metal. At first glance, the planes appear delicate and ephemeral, but upon closer inspection, their robustness becomes apparent.

The paper plane also holds a universal symbolism, representing the human desire for flight and freedom. Through the scale and materiality of his work, Sigalot elevates this symbol to a new level, inviting us to explore our own aspirations and dreams.

Overall, Sigalot's paper planes serve as a reminder of the power of art to transform the ordinary into the extraordinary, and to provoke us to think critically about the world around us.





## Spiritual Body





An original, archetypal G&G multi-part artwork was created using a free file that was available for 48 hours. Nielsen USA created black glossy metal frames that mimic the typical G&G proportions and style.

The background is made up of warped pictures of the plane tree's leaves and fruit, with the title referencing the tree itself. It is a tree that is particularly connected with London, and for 40 years, the majority of Gilbert & George's work has been influenced by the texture of London streets, from street art to graffiti and newspaper advertising.

To the question as to whether Malevich and Mondrian have not already said everything that can be said with a square Josef Albers answers: "No. Mondrian never painted a correct, precise square. And Malevich only rarely showed it mathematically. I believe that, fundamentally there is no ultimate solution in visual formulation. Each and every form demands repeated 'performance'."

BIEST is a tool which can help you open your perception to new possibilities, and realize them at once. The sheer desire to be manifests into fashion, a "performative utterance". Body and space are intricate co-creators of the BIEST art project. A room full of possibilities: Room to think, be free, separate, creative, protected, and to drift off into anther dimension. To live in the physical world signifies more than anything to exist in material form, and as such we occupy space. This serves as a reminder that dimensional thinking and the development of spatial constructions are not off-springs of the late 'topographical turn', but rather mark the beginning of philosophy itself.

This contemporary art tattoo by British artist TRACEY EMIN is called "Singing Bird".

It depicts a small sitting (or flying?) bird on the penis. Tracey Emin designed the image as a one-of-a-kind temporary tattoo that would be distributed by the British Consulate to Biennale Venice attendees in 2007 in a limited edition of 1500.

No commercial edition was ever released.





The handcrafted resin sculpture known as "Little LoveBomb" was inspired by Iskander Walen's renowned LoveBomb series, which combines a female breast and an aerial bomb.

LoveBomb is a commentary on the taboo of nudity versus the acceptance, if not celebration, of violence as a form of visual entertainment.

Iskander Walen is a well-known artist whose work has been shown in numerous solo and group exhibitions across North America, Europe, and Asia. His sculptures and paintings frequently contain humor and offer an original perspective on contradictions and contradictions in society.



'We are driven by everything that is slightly taboo, by the forbidden.' Sexuality is a central theme of Gilbert & George's work, which is explored in images that are often provocative and disconcerting. Hunger and Thirst show a sexual act that is depicted in a cartoon-like, almost diagrammatic, manner. The artists have commented on these works: 'we wanted to confront the viewers in a museum, as normally you don't see this stuff, and make them accept it. It was done in a cartoon like way because in reality they would never have been accepted at that time'.



The thumbs-up hand signal is almost always used to express gratitude or contentment with something or someone.

Although many historians have proposed roots much further back, possibly even before spoken language, the gesture has a history that dates at least to the Ancient Roman era.

In recent times, it has become synonymous with Facebook's "like" feature. Due to the fact that people who are looking for transportation use the thumbs up along the sides of roads, it could also represent hitchhiking.





The piece is from the "True Mirror Works" series, which is a collection of lacquered text works for mirrors.

They all address the audience critically with statements and funny questions, frequently focusing on the perfect social media image. You can ask yourself this question every day for self-reflection by working with this text.

René Holm started out as a graffiti artist and is now one of the most well-known contemporary artists in Denmark. Over the years, his work has been displayed at trade shows from Basel to Miami.

Barbara Kruger, who previously worked as a graphic designer for popular magazines, gained recognition in the art world for photobased images superimposed with text blocks in black, white, and red color schemes between the late 1970s and the early 1980s.
